THE BRIEF

Demolish existing original Blue café, equipment, cabinetry, flooring and construct a fresh, modern, more spacious café counter and working area, to provide patrons with an inviting relaxed atmosphere.

THE SOLUTION

Create a unified counter with a modern look, giving the café an open lighter spacious feel. Increase countertop and working space for staff and create glass display cabinets to blend in with counter heights





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Collaboration began with the AJ Grant team, Director of Culinary Development and the Board of Directors for guidance on requirements, timeframes and budgets for the proposed re-design. AJ Grant then engaged our commercial joinery contractor C2G Commercial to design a concept that would expand the benchtop area, allowing enough space for both equipment storage, glass displays and staff to prepare food. The main focus was expanding on the existing layout to maximise and increase benchtop and serving areas without losing any existing table spaces and seating.

Demolition began by installing temporary boarding to the area and setting up a temporary coffee cart and display fridge to enable the café to continue serving customers while works proceeded within the area behind the boarding with no disturbance from dust or noise during the works.

Prior to works commencing on site, an agreed program for the works with start and completion dates was arranged with the client. Once design and equipment was signed off, the manufacturing of cabinetry commenced at C2G Commercial's factory.

The delivery of materials for manufacture included:

- POLYTEC - NATURAL OAK RAVINE with a V groove detail and clear sealed
- STARON - SP011 PEARL (Staron® Solid Surfaces is manufactured from a natural mineral refined from bauxite and blended with pure acrylic resin.)
- Black coated Aluminium kickboards
- Stainless steel benchtops

After the installation of the cabinetry, our in-house tiler and trades installed the white subway tiles to the walls for the splashbacks and carried out the preparation of the floor to apply a coved edge black epoxy floor which provides a safe non-slip floor finish and easy to clean for spills and hygienic food preparation areas.

- Benchtops space increased from approximately 3 - 9 metres
- Installation of fridges, ice machines, cooking equipment and additional glass displays
- Lighter colour scheme creating the illusion of a larger room
- Much larger preparation and work area for staff and serving area for customers
