Prime Instructions | Inserting Job Custom Fields Into A Form

There are two ways to display the job custom fields in a Form:

1. Insert the tag [jobCustomFields]

This will display all fields on a job

2. Insert the tag with this format:

[jobCustomFields.{replace-this-with-category-tag-reference}]

This will display just that category. The tag reference can be found in the category editor.
